

Retraction of PhD Allocations from Institutions supported under
“ Visvesvaraya PhD Scheme for Electronics and IT”

It has been observed that some of the institute supported under “Visvesvaraya PhD Scheme for Electronics and IT” are not able to enroll at least 50% of the approvals (allocated) PhD candidates in a given Academic Year.

50 % (rounded to the nearest integer) of the unfilled PhD Allocations will be withdrawn from such institutes and these Institutes would be allowed to carry forward only remaining (after 50% withdrawal) PhD allocations to the next academic year.

However, the Institutions which have performed well and are able to enroll at least 50% or more of the approved PhD allocations in a given year, do not need to relinquish any PhD allocations. Such institutes can fill the remaining positions till the next academic year. Such extensions will be allowed automatically for one year.
